



Tik Tok Summer Challenge

To involve Jefferson County high schools and students in a contest to create the most popular anti-litter Tik Tok video is a fun (hopefully effective) way to engage and educate more people about the negative and harmful effects of litter. It is also a terrific platform to spread the message to what would otherwise be a hard-to-reach population. While the videos in the Litter Quitters Video Competition get several thousand views, utilizing other media techniques / platforms to promote this same anti-littering message through the voices of students will allow us additional opportunities to reach many more hundreds of thousands of people.

<u>Who can participate?</u> Students, ages 14-22 that live in, or will be attending a school/college in Jefferson County, Alabama for the upcoming academic year.

<u>What is the contest?</u> Create an anti-litter themed message in a video format no longer than 60 seconds using your personal Tik Tok profile trying to obtain the most 'likes' during a set time frame for a \$100 cash prize. Participants can compete individually or as a group (prize money will be split among all members).

How to win: There are 2 categories for consideration: One video will be awarded based on likes during the given time frame. This participant(s) will win \$100. One video will be awarded for best content, chosen by the committee. This participant(s) will win \$100. One video has the potential to win both prizes.

Rules of the Challenge:

- ✓ Videos should focus on portraying a message that the action of littering is bad and has negative consequences on our general environment, neighborhoods and communities, waterways, and wildlife.
- ✓ Participants are encouraged to watch recorded presentations about litter on www.LitterQuitters.org.
- ✓ Videos should be positive, encouraging with a call to action.
 - ✓ Videos that portray a negative, demeaning, or inappropriate message or contain inappropriate language by participants in the video or within music used with the video will not be considered.
- ✓ Your video must include the specific hashtags in the caption: #BeALitterQuitter2022 #LitteringIsStupid
 - ☑ Videos cannot contain copyrighted music but may use music available through the Tik Tok app when uploading the video. Original music used by local bands must provide a media waiver.
- ✓ 2 categories eligible for prizes of \$100 each: Video with the most likes, video with the best content.



- ✓ Participants need to turn in an entry form and upload their video between July 1-15th for the competition, Any early uploads will be deducted likes based on July 1st. Participants may enter a video any time during the competition window; however, videos trying to win the most likes should enter as early as possible.
- ✓ The deadline for "likes" to be counted and videos to be uploaded will be July 15th, 11:59 pm. A Committee member will contact you if you have won either category.
- ✓ The Litter Quitters Committee is the final arbitrator of the contest and whether a video entry is eligible for winning, regardless of the number of "likes."
- ✓ Videos can not exceed 60 seconds.

<u>How to participate</u>: participants must contact the Litter Quitters Committee by email at <u>jefferson@alconservationdistricts.org</u> to receive and turn in an entry form with the link to your video for consideration by the set <u>deadline</u>: <u>July 15, 2022</u>. If all forms are not complete by the set deadline, entries will not be considered. *If you're under 18, a parent MUST sign off on the form before an entry can be considered.*
